There are many ways your computer can get infected with adware, malware, spyware, ransomware and viruses.

### **1. Agreeing without reading through**

Undoubtedly the most prevalent means a computer gets infected with virus is when a user agrees whatever they see on the display without reading through the prompt before continuing especially when installing applications online. When online ads or maybe screen display shows up with information that your system is infected or rather your system is running slow or that a special plug-in is needed. And without reading through and fully knowing what you are going to use and you agree to the prompt.

### **2. By an infected Disk or USB drive**

Every disk or thumb drive inserted into a computer system will be contaminated with a virus if the computer is infected. Provided that any media is writable, a computer virus can get into it from an infected computer. A general approach hackers use to gain entry into a network is actually by leaving a thumb drive with harmful script onto it. After that, any user that inserts the thumb drive to their system, it gets attacked by the virus.

### **3. Pirated Software, Music, or Movies**

When you use your pc for bit torrent program and other illegitimate exchange of copyrighted software, movies or music, you are likely to be in danger of virus infection. Often times, these files or programs hold viruses or even hazardous software.

### **4. Download of any Infected Program**

Each time you're downloading any specific software, be it games, utilities, updates and so on through internet, ensure you are accessing the software from trusted source. Also, ensure to use antivirus and malware scanner to analyze downloads. When installing software, study all prompts in regards to what else the program is adding on your system.

## 5. Not running the most up-to-date software

Most of the updates, particularly those related to Microsoft Windows, are safety focused. Ensure you have the operating system and also other programs on your computer updated to the recent version. The plug-ins related to your web browser may hold security risks too. To ensure you have the most recent updates, you can run your PC Hope tool to verify installed plug-ins in addition to their versions.

### Ways to Avoid Getting A Computer Repairs Virus

**Don't use Windows XP:** Official support ended on 8th April 2014. This means support and security updates are no longer available. If you continue to use Windows XP, your computer will become vulnerable to security risks & viruses. As time goes on, fewer devices and programs will work with Windows XP.

**Use another internet browser:** If you use Internet Explorer or maybe outdated browser like safari or even netscape for Windows OS, you will be exposing your system to security threats. Browsers like Chrome, Opera and Firefox are considerably more protected compared to outdated browsers, and they're even easier to customize. Firefox & Chrome, have got a huge range of add-ons relating to both privacy and security which you can use to secure your system on the web.

However, in the event you really do not wish to change browsers, then ensure that you have updated version to avert infection.

**Avoid deceptive popups:** Probably the most heinous popups online are intended to appear like genuine. Most of these popups try to mislead the user into believing their antivirus program has detected virus infection, but by the

time you decide to click on the popup, the adware will be automatically installed on your machine.

When those popups appear, never attempt clicking on the “X” to exit the popup display, because this will often bring about more popups. Using the ALT+F4 keys will close browser windows. Alternatively, use the system “Task Manager” to close it completely. Installing adblock plus can help to protect against popup advertisements showing up at all.
